

Veterinary Technician Internship-Cleveland Amory Black Beauty Ranch

This internship is intended for recent graduates of an accredited AVMA veterinary technician program. It will provide you with hands-on clinical experience with a variety of large animal and exotic species. Under the supervision and direction of the clinic’s veterinarian and veterinary technician, interns will participate in various aspects of veterinary medicine.

Clinical pathology: fecal analysis, urine analysis, manual CBC’s, cytology, ordering labs, etc.	Hospital maintenance: stocking supplies, utility room processing, adding to order list, etc.
Immobilizations: anesthesia monitoring, setting up for field procedures, phlebotomy, radiology, cleanup, etc.	Medical records: utilizing ZIMS, data entry, filing, etc.
Equipment: ensure equipment is clean and charged, proper handling, etc.	Patients: daily care, observe changes in status, feed and medicate, etc.

-Be prepared for extreme weather. Most cases are seen outside in all weather conditions which can be unpredictable in east Texas.

-Interns are scheduled to work at least 40 hours per week. A stipend and free housing are provided.

-Must have proof of negative tuberculosis test. Tetanus and pre-exposure rabies vaccines recommended.
