- Assist in personnel training of laboratory equipment operation and procedures.

- A Bachelor's or an Associate's degree in a science discipline and experience as a Medical Technologist or Medical Lab Technician.
- A current license from the State of Florida Board of Health as a Medical Technologist or Medical Lab Technician.

- Availability to work varying shifts or hours based on park hours; i.e. be able to work opening and closing shifts.
