

Sedgwick County Zoo is a large zoo, located in Wichita, Kansas. We are home to 3,000 individual animals of nearly 400 species. We have over 200 employees on staff.

We are a three doctor/three technician, full service veterinary hospital with up to date facilities. Our hospital has up to date diagnostic tools, such as a new radiology unit, multiple ultrasound units, endoscopy, and thermal imaging. We provide internship training at our zoo with plenty of hands on experiences. Students will work with technicians to perform daily tasks as well as appropriate handling of emergencies, surgeries, and dangerous situations.

Students must be currently enrolled in an accredited Veterinary Technology program. A 4-6 week commitment of 30-40 hours per week is preferred though duration of stay may be flexible with prior approval. It is recommended that the student have previous animal care/ veterinary assistant experience. A negative TB test (or negative chest radiograph) within 12 months is required and current rabies and tetanus vaccinations are highly recommended. There is no housing on site, but we can provide information on housing leads. No stipend is available. Students must be over 18.
